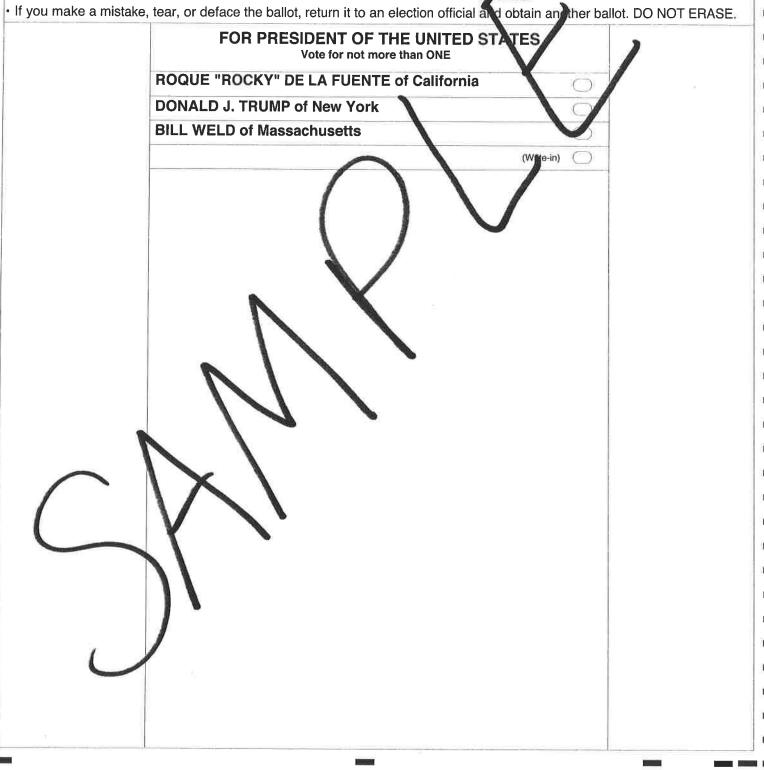

Shall the voters of the Union High School D strict No. 27 approve the school board to expend \$7,287,628.06 (Seven midion two hundred eighty-seven thousand, six hundred twenty eight dollars and six cents) which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, while result in education spending of \$18,658.81 (eighteen thousand, six hundred fifty-eight dollars and eighty-one cents) per equalized pupil. This project d spending per equalized pupil is 4.42% higher than spending for the current year.
