For development in the Special Flood Hazard Zone (SFHA):

Per Grafton Town Flood Damage Prevention Regulations, Section 8:

All development within the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA)shall be reasonably safe from flooding and:

- 1. Designed (or modified) and adequately anchored to prevent flotation, collapse or lateral movement of the structure during the occurrence of the base flood,
- 2. Constructed with materials resistant to flood damage,
- 3. Constructed by methods and practices that minimize flood damage, and
- 4. Constructed with electrical, heating, ventilation, plumbing, air conditioning equipment and other service facilities that are designed and/or located to prevent water from entering or accumulating within the components during conditions of flooding.

Do not commence development until the Town Administrative Officer has signed off on this notification (or if the development is in the SFHA, until a permit is issued by the Town Administrative Officer).
