The total quoted is \$See below. All labor and material are factored into this quote to the best of our knowledge.

Scope of work:

Scope #1 work associated to accommodate new elevator. Demo outlet, wire under window, power in small closet, relocate light. This work is estimated to be \$1,600 (doesn't include Country Side work)

Scope #2 upgrading electrical service from 100amp to 200amp. See attached sketch of proposed work. Quote is based on 50' of underground conduit and wire. Install new two gang meter socket and run wire to new 200amp panel. Install 100amp sub panel for all circuits to be on generator backup. Doesn't include GMP costs or associated site work. This work is estimated to be \$7,960

Scope #3 install (2) floor outlets one w/ (1) data line. Add (3) outlets on wall of second floor meeting area. Using surface mount EMT conduit. This work is estimated to be \$2,290

Note during scope #2 both Town Hall and Post Office will be without power for one full day. All quotes are for normal work hours (M-F, 7am-4pm). Includes all permitting. Excluded is GMP fees and site work.

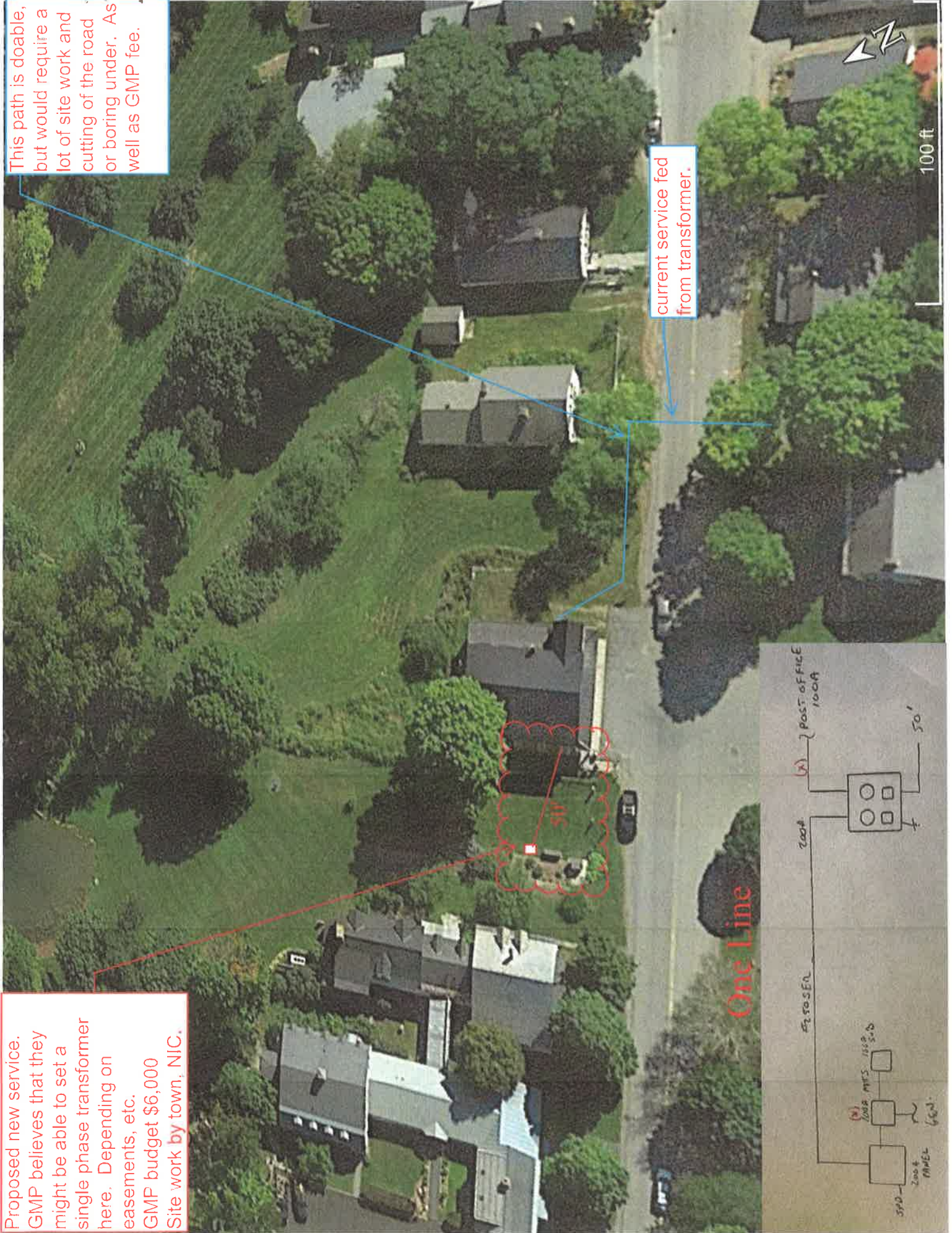
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Proposed new service. GMP believes that they might be able to set a single phase transformer here. Depending on easements, etc. GMP budget \$6,000 Site work by town, NIC.
