TOWN OF GRAFTON'S PRIVATE ROAD SIGNING STANDARDS

It is the policy of the Grafton Select Board that the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) be applied to road signs on private roads. Road name signs on private roads shall meet the requirements of MUTCD. The owner(s) of property on private roads, who want or are required by any regulation to have the road named must: 1.) have the name approved by the Grafton Selectboard, which shall assure that the name will be E911 compliant and not likely result in a name so similar to a road of a similar name as to cause confusion in emergency response; 2.) the owner(s) shall purchase the sign and post through the Town of Grafton (Town) and pay the Town \$20.00 for each installation of the sign(s) at the time the sign is purchased; 3.) the owner(s) shall not purchase or install the sign on its/their own; and 4.) the owner(s) assume the liability for the maintenance or replacement of damaged or stolen road signs, which maintenance or replacement shall be done by or through the Town and paid for by the owner as in 2.) above.

A letter will be sent to all property owners wishing to install a road sign on any private road explaining the policy.
