[Grafton Bridge #20 Replacement Project]

Construction Update

DATE: Friday, February 9, 2024

TRAFFIC IMPACT AND DURATION: Monday, February 12 through Friday, February 16, there is potential for intermittent single-lane closures with alternating one-way traffic controlled by flaggers on Fisher Hill Road.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES: The independent utility companies have completed their work to relocate the aerial electrical and communications utilities within the project area.

The contractor will be on-site next week to complete installing the causeway within the Saxtons River. The subcontractor, H.B. Fleming, will begin mobilizing their equipment to the project area in preparation for the upcoming installation of the drilled shaft foundation for the new bridge. Crews are anticipated to begin drilling for the new foundation during the week of February 19, 2024.

LOCATION: On Vermont Route 121 East in the Town of Grafton over the Saxtons River, just east of the intersection with Fisher Hill Road.

PROJECTED COMPLETION: Fall 2024
