Construction Update

DATE: Friday, February 16, 2024

TRAFFIC IMPACT AND DURATION: Monday, February 19 through Friday, February 23, between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., there is potential for intermittent stoppages and single-lane closures with alternating one-way traffic controlled by flaggers on VT 121 and Fisher Hill Road.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES: Monday, February 19 through Friday, February 23, crews will be on-site to install demolition containment on the north side of the existing bridge.

The delivery of the drill rig for the installation of the drilled shaft foundation is scheduled for early next week, with drilling work anticipated to begin on Tuesday, February 20.
