## [Grafton Bridge #20 Replacement Project]

### Construction Update

**DATE:** Friday, March 22, 2024

**TRAFFIC IMPACT AND DURATION:** Travel over Bridge #20 along Vermont Route 121 in Grafton, Vt. is permanently reduced to a single lane along the southern portion of the bridge, with alternating one-way traffic controlled by traffic signals.

The traffic signals will remain in place 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, until the new bridge is constructed and opened to traffic. ***Motorists are reminded to follow all traffic signals, slow down, and use caution as they travel within the work zone.***

**CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES:** Crews will be on-site Monday, March 25 through Friday, March 29, between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., to continue pre-drilling for the new pile foundations at the bridge abutments. Crews will install sheet piling at both bridge abutments for excavation support.

Crews will begin to remove the northern portion of the existing bridge's piers and abutments, after completing the removal of the northern portion of the bridge's superstructure.

**LOCATION:** On Vermont Route 121 East in the Town of Grafton over the Saxtons River, just east of the intersection with Fisher Hill Road.

**PROJECTED COMPLETION:** Fall 2024
