## [Grafton Bridge #20 Replacement Project]

### Construction Update

**DATE:** Friday, March 29, 2024

**TRAFFIC IMPACT AND DURATION:** Travel over Bridge #20 along Vermont Route 121 in Grafton, Vt. is permanently reduced to a single lane along the southern portion of the bridge, with alternating one-way traffic controlled by traffic signals.

The traffic signals will remain in place 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, until the new bridge is constructed and opened to traffic. ***Motorists are reminded to follow all traffic signals, slow down, and use caution as they travel within the work zone.***

**CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES:** Crews will be on-site Monday, April 1 through Friday, April 5, between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., to continue installing temporary sheeting to support the roadway at both bridge abutments while constructing the new bridge. Crews will subsequently begin excavation work for the new bridge abutments. The subcontractor will begin pre-drilling for the piles on the second bridge abutment.

**LOCATION:** On Vermont Route 121 East in the Town of Grafton over the Saxtons River, just east of the intersection with Fisher Hill Road.

**PROJECTED COMPLETION:** Fall 2024
