[Grafton Bridge #20 Replacement Project]

Construction Update

DATE: Friday, June 14, 2024

TRAFFIC IMPACT AND DURATION: Travel over Bridge #20 on Vermont Route 121 over the Saxtons River in Grafton, Vt. is now permanently reduced to a single lane along the southern portion of the bridge, with alternating one-way traffic controlled by traffic signals. These signals will remain in place 24 hours a day, 7 days a week until the new bridge is constructed and opened to traffic. *Motorists are reminded to follow all traffic signals, slow down, and exercise caution while traveling within the work zone.*

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES: Monday, June 17, through Friday, June 21, between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., the subcontractor will be on-site to continue installing the drilled shaft into the bedrock within the Saxtons River.



Crews complete the installation of the second bridge abutment and stone fill along the Saxton River's edge.

LOCATION: On Vermont Route 121 in the Town of Grafton over the Saxtons River, just east of the intersection with Fisher Hill Road.

PROJECTED COMPLETION: Fall 2024
