

[Grafton Bridge #20 Replacement Project]

Final Construction Update and End-of-Season Survey Announcement

DATE: Friday, December 20, 2024

TRAFFIC IMPACT AND DURATION: Today, December 20, between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., crews will complete preparations for the winter shutdown outside the roadway. Traffic impacts are not anticipated. By 5 p.m., crews will be off-site for the winter and will return in Spring 2025.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES: This week, crews finished removing the existing bridge, restoring the Saxtons River stream bed at the former bridge pier locations, and installing stone fill along the slopes of the Saxtons River channel to stabilize the banks and prevent erosion.

This is the final Construction Update for the 2024 construction season. Construction activities will resume in spring 2025.

LOCATION: On Vermont Route 121 in the Town of Grafton over the Saxtons River, just east of the intersection with Fisher Hill Road.
